- **If blue-green starts at position 4:** Blue would be at position 4 and green at position 5. Red must be next to blue, so red would be at position 3. This leaves position 2 for yellow. Check the clues: purple at position 1, yellow at position 2, red at position 3, blue at position 4, green at position 5. Red is next to blue? Yes (positions 3 and 4). Green is next to yellow? Positions 5 and 2 are not adjacent—they are at opposite ends of the necklace. This clue fails. So this configuration is invalid.

Step 5: The Correct Solution

Only one arrangement satisfies all four clues: Purple, Red, Blue, Green, Yellow (from left to right). If you placed purple at the right end instead, the mirror arrangement would be Yellow, Green, Blue, Red, Purple. Both are correct depending on which end you started with.
