- Dragonbane** (2015) – Max and Seraphina.
- Dragonmark** (2016) – Illarion and Edilyn.
- Dragon's Lament** (2016) – A standalone novel.
- Dead Men Do Tell Tales** (2017) – A collection of novellas.
- Dark Bites** (2017) – A short story collection.
- Night Unbound** (2019) – A novella bridging arcs.
- Vampire in Atlantis** (2021) – Balthazar and Elysia.
